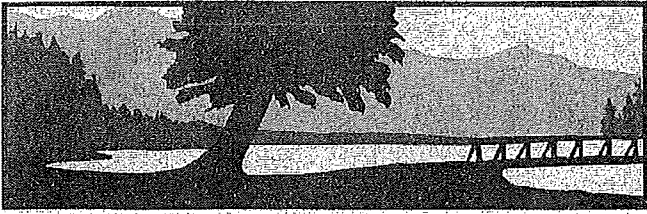
DISCUSSION:

At the April 29, 2015 Board meeting the Park Board received the 2014 Audited Financial Statements. During the presentation, the Board's auditors KPMG made a recommendation to undertake an assessment of the landfill in order to determine if the landfill liability needs to be revised, as the previous estimate was completed in 2002.

Staff have contacted Sperling Hansen Associates Inc., the authors of the original closure plan, who has given an estimate of \$1,000 to update their report.

The current balance of the Landfill Closure Reserve Fund is \$9,132.

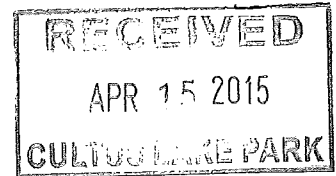

The Saturday Market in the Park is trying to comply with the new direction the Park Board has asked us to go. In order to do this we need the written permission from the Board to be allowed to bring in Food Carts/ Food trucks. We have contacted the Health Department to find out what is necessary for us to bring in Food Trucks. They informed us each Food truck / cart must have a numbered decal plus a written permit in order to operate. They inspect each vehicle before granting the permit. RE: Open Fires in Parks land

It was suggested to me that I send this letter to all board members as we do not now have a CAO.

I would like to bring to your attention something in the Good Neighbor Bylaw that I and my family feels is not fair and could easily be fixed. Before I explain I do want to say I have had many Leaseholders agree with me and mention that they felt it was not fair either. Although I only speak for myself and my family, I know I am not alone.

In the new Good Neighbor Bylaw there are no longer free standing fires allowed by the leaseholders of homes. For as many years as I can remember we have had open fires and leaseholders have been very respectful and there has been no major problems.

In Sunnyside Campground as well as Vedder River Campground they are allowed open fires. This despite that fact that in Sunnyside most of the fires are within 3 feet of a Pine tree and in Vedder River the fires are within 5 feet of a camper and under 8 foot plastic tarps. By the way I do not think this is an issue as I camped at Vedder River for 5 years and Sunnyside for 10 years and never saw a problem.

I just feel that it is unfair to allow open fires in the campgrounds and not in the leasehold residential areas. To me an open fire is part of Lake Life. Nothing can beat sitting around a real open wood fire and roasting marshmallows and telling stories or singing songs. Yes that is my voice sometimes sorry!

I also feel the Leaseholders have a much larger sense of responsibility to Cultus as they are true stake holders with large investments. Leaseholders would be the last people to abuse an open fire. Even renters of some of the Leaseholder homes have between \$500 and \$1000 deposits verses nothing in the camp sites.

I believe that it is possible that this people who wrote the Good Naighbor Bylaw did not take into account the idea of fairness with the leaseholders compared to the campers and the fact that the leaseholders would be the last people to abuse the lake and its beauty.

Although section 9, Good Naighbor Bylaw allows for free-standing fireplaces- but not open fires in the residential area, it is just not the same. Sunnyside Bylaw section 18 allows open fires in the provided rings. It should be noted all freestanding fires I know of by the the Leaseholders land are also in fire rings, like the ones provided at Sunnyside and Vedder. Because of this I feel, the Good Naighbor Bylaw is unfair, discriminatory, and unjust to leaseholders compared to the Sunnyside Bylaw and I would ask that the Good Naighbor Bylaw be changed to allow open fires in the residential area.

I could even see some conditions on the bylaw such as no fire within 10 feet of a home and all fires to be in a fire ring. If you saw my fire it is in a fire ring in the middle of a 16 by 16 foot brick deck over 30 feet from my home. It may be that homes on some of the so called tree streets may not have the room that homes on Mountain View and Park have and therefor you can set a rule about being so many feet from

a building. This would still allow many of those lots to have an open fire, some place on their lot. But I assure you my fire has to be one of the safest at the Lake and the ones I see on leaseholder land are all in very safe places. Let's face it we all want to be safe and we all love the lake. But really an open fire is an important part of the lake for many of us.

You could only allow open fires in fire rings in backyards, or in truck rim or a brick ring that is easy to build. I do know, not only is it safe, but much safer than the campgrounds.

I and my family would ask that you please amend the Good Neighbor Bylaw so that the residents of leaseholder property can enjoy open fires this season for the summer. It would be fair, it would be in keeping with what the campsites can do for \$35 a night and it would make many families happy to be able to continue having what they feel is a true Lake experience.

It goes without saying that when the Park Board puts a fire ban on due to dry weather all campsites and leaseholders must respect that ban for the safety of the Park.

My family and I thank you for taking the time to consider this request. I hope it seems fair and balanced to you and I am grateful we now have a Board that cares about what the leaseholders feel and what they want. I look forward to the board considering and making the necessary changes to the Good Neighbor Bylaw so we can enjoy open fires in our backyards this summer.

VEDDER RIVER CAMPGROUND BYLAW NO. 1067, AMENDMENT NO. 1

A BYLAW TO AMEND THE VEDDER RIVER CAMPGROUND
BYLAW NO. 1067

Adopted (--/--/----

WHEREAS Section 12 of the Cultus Lake Park Act (1932 and Amendments) enables the Cultus Lake Park Board to adopt bylaws;

AND WHEREAS the Cultus Lake Park Board has adopted the Vedder River Campground Bylaw No. 1067, 2015 on March 18, 2015;

AND WHEREAS the Cultus Lake Park Board now deems it advisable to amend the said Vedder River Campground Bylaw No. 1067, 2015;

NOW THEREFORE the Cultus Lake Park Board in open meeting assembled, HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. TITLE
