Cultus Lake Park Bylaw No. 1030 - 12

RESERVE FUND REALLOCATION BYLAW

WHEREAS Section 12 of the *Cultus Lake Park Act* authorizes the Cultus Lake Park Board to establish a reserve fund for a specific purpose;

AND WHEREAS Section 188 of the *Community Charter* provides for the establishment of reserve funds by bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE the Cultus Lake Park Board in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

- 1. That a reserve fund reallocation be hereby established under the provisions of Section 12 of the *Cultus Lake Park Act* and Section 188 of the *Community Charter* to be known as the "Reserve Fund Reallocation".
- 2. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Reserve Fund Reallocation Bylaw No. 1030-12".
- 3. The following bylaws shall have opening balances as follows:
