BE BEAR AWARE

Spring means bears (including mother bears and cubs) will be out in the local forest areas.

HELP PREVENT BEAR-HUMAN ENCOUNTERS:

- Don't leave garbage out.
- Clean barbecue grills after each use and store in a secure area.
 - Bring pet food dishes inside and store the pet food inside.
- Do not dump any food compost in areas that may attract wildlife and store composting in a sealed compost container.

If you spot a bear: Remain calm, keep away from the bear and bring children and pets indoors, if possible.

NEVER approach a bear and do not run from it (bears can move quickly).
