CANCELLATION POLICY

Seven days prior to reservation date, cancellation fees will apply. No refunds after check-in, no exceptions.

Groupsite: 30 days prior to reservation date, cancellation fees will apply.

QUIET TIME

11:00 pm to 7:00 am

Respect your neighbours: keep all sounds within your site. Amplified sound systems are not permitted at any time.

The use of generators is prohibited.

All gates are closed from 10:00 pm to 8:00 am.

Beaches close at 11:00 pm.

All minors (18 & younger) must be in their sites by 11:00 pm unless accompanied by an adult.

CAMPFIRES AND FIREWOOD

Daily campfire hours: 7:00 am to 1:00 pm

5:00 pm to 11:00 pm

Hours in effect unless otherwise advised by the Campground Manager. Fires must be contained in fire rings provided. FIRES MUST BE ATTENDED BY AN ADULT AT ALL TIMES.

Use only clean, dry wood (max. 18" in length), no painted or pressure treated wood.

VISITORS

DAY VISITORS are required to leave the campground by $11:00~\rm pm$ OVERNIGHT VISITORS are required to depart by $11:00~\rm am$ on the date of pass expiry.

No entry for visitors after 10:00 pm.

Additional fees apply.

CAMPING SUPPLIES

Firewood is for sale at the gatehouse during low season office hours. We also sell **electrical adaptors**.

SUNNYSIDE GENERAL STORE

Provides ice, ice cream, food, firewood, camping & personal supplies, and much more!

Operating hours as posted.

NO LIFEGUARDS ON DUTY

The safety of children is the sole responsibility of guardians.

PLAYGROUND

Unsupervised playground – use at own risk.

Closed at dusk.

SITE OCCUPANCY

ONE camping unit or two tents

ONE motor vehicle

2 registered adults per site

Charges will apply for additional registered adults and vehicles (maximum two additional adults for a site total of four; and maximum two vehicles per site)

ONE picnic table (provided)

ONE fire ring (provided)

PARKING

Overflow parking is available at the gatehouse.

Parking is prohibited in reserved parking areas.

Fees apply for all campground parking.

ALCOHOL

Alcoholic beverages may be consumed within campsite boundaries ONLY. The *Liquor Control and Licensing Act* shall apply. Consumption in public areas is illegal. Violators shall be subject to charge.

Cultus Lake Park is a smoke-free community.

Smoking is permitted only within registered campsites.

VEHICLES

Unlicensed vehicles are prohibited within the campground (dirt bikes, 3-wheelers, golf carts, electric bikes, etc). Vehicles without valid passes displayed in the Campground are subject to charges and/or towing at the owner's expense.

PETS

Daily fees apply.

Pets must be secured or leashed at all times and under control of the handler. Handlers of pets are responsible for cleaning up after their pet(s).

Pets are not permitted within the playground areas; on beaches, wharves, or in the lake (unless it is within dog swim areas, indicated on map).

Pets that repeatedly disturb the quiet enjoyment of the campground will be required to be removed by their handler.

RECYCLING

Please deposit recyclable beverage containers in recycling receptacles throughout the campground.

TREES

It is prohibited to cut, trim or damage trees, which includes fallen trees.

The use of nails, screws, or any material which could damage a tree is prohibited.

Violators are subject to charge.

PLEASE RESPECT OUR CAMPGROUND

- Use garbage bins provided (not firepits)
- ✓ Leave all natural vegetation unharmed. Only ropes or other tying devices may be attached to trees (no nails, screws, etc).
- ✔ Observe posted speed limits.
