



NOTICE TO RESIDENTS AND SUNNYSIDE CAMPERS

Residents and campers have noticed an increase in theft over the past several weeks. Cultus Lake Park's intent is to increase surveillance throughout the season.

Below are some tips to mitigate theft from your property.

MAKE CRIMINALS EASIER TO SPOT

Criminals like to operate in the shadows where they can't be seen. By keeping your property well lit, you make it much more difficult for them to do so. Consider installing motion-sensor lights around the perimeter of your home. This makes them easier to spot if they do try something. It may be beneficial to install cameras on your property.

GET TO KNOW YOUR NEIGHBOURS

One of the best ways to deter thieves is to have a good relationship with your neighbours. Thieves are less likely to target a community where everyone knows each other and looks out for one another. If you don't already know your neighbours, take some time to introduce yourself.

DON'T ADVERTISE POSSESSIONS

Another way to deter criminals is to not advertise your possessions. If you have valuable items that can be seen from outside your home, criminals will be tempted to break in and steal them. Keep valuables out of sight and don't leave them in plain view in your car, either. Using fences, gates, curtains, and keeping windows and doors closed are all effective ways to deter thieves from targeting the Cultus Lake Park community and campground.

SECURE YOUR PROPERTY

Keep your garage, car, windows and doors locked when you are not home and double check accesses at night.

REPORT IT
