1. **Radon Test Kits Returns-** If any of you have a Radon test kit it is time to return it. Take Action on Radon will be sending out reminder emails shortly to those who received a test kit and registered it with Take Action. This email will include instructions on how residents may return the used kits. Residents in our region will be advised they can return the kits between March 31 and April 11 to Cultus Lake Parks Board Office (4165 Columbia Valley Hwy, Cultus Lake).

Thanks in advance for returning the kits. FVRD will receive a summary in July and individual homeowners should receive their results in May or June.

3. **Paving-** Just a heads up that they will be paving Frost Road March 29, 31, April 1, April 2, and Iverson Road April 2-4. The paving does depend on the weather. Please watch for flaggers and signage.
4. **Fire Smart-** On April 28<sup>th</sup> a chipper will once again pick up branches and trimming from the Parkview area.( Sleepy Hollow, Vance, Elizabeth, Karen, Joyce, Linzey, Gurney) Trimming and removing dead branches and material helps keep our area safer. 5. **Goose Management 2025-** Our Cultus Lake Goose Management Committee will be back in action again this spring. Our purpose is to manage the number of Canada Geese or hybrid Canada Geese at Cultus Lake. We have received our permit to search for nests and addle/oil eggs and only trained volunteers are able to do this. We try to educate the public of the importance of not feeding geese. Our group has provided Goose Signs that you will see on the garbage cans within BC Parks and Cultus Lake Park Board area. We also have pamphlets available that are handed out during some of the community events. If you happen to see a goose sitting on a nest, please do not approach it yourself but send an email to me with the location.
